

# Michigan Collaborative Standardization of Compounded Oral Liquids

<b>Drug name:</b>	<b>Flucytosine</b> (alternate conc)	<b>Dosage Form:</b>	Suspension
<b>Concentration:</b>	50 mg/mL	<b>Shelf Life:</b>	90 days
<b>Route:</b>	Oral	<b>Storage:</b>	Room Temp
<b>Volume:</b>	120 mL	<b>Auxiliary Labeling:</b>	Shake Well

Ingredients	QS	Quantity	Units
Flucytosine 250 mg		24	Capsules
Ora-Plus	Y	60	mL
Ora-Sweet NF	Y	60	mL

## Directions:

1. Open flucytosine capsules and empty contents into a mortar
2. Triturate into a fine powder
3. Mix 60 mL Ora-Plus with 60 mL Ora-Sweet NF to form a base solution – shake well before use
4. Add a small amount of base solution to powder and levigate to form a paste
5. Add base solution via geometric dilution, almost to volume, mixing thoroughly with each addition
6. Transfer contents to a graduated cylinder
7. Rinse mortar and pestle with base solution and pour into graduated cylinder
8. QS with base solution to 120 mL
9. Transfer contents to a plastic amber bottle
10. Shake well

## Notes:

- May substitute base solution with 60 mL of strawberry syrup mixed with 60 mL of Ora-Plus (strawberry syrup is prepared by mixing 160 mL of Simple Syrup NF and 30 mL of strawberry fountain syrup).
