

# Michigan Collaborative Standardization of Compounded Oral Liquids

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<b>Drug name:</b>	<b>Primaquine</b>	<b>Dosage Form:</b>	Suspension
<b>Concentration:</b>	6 mg base/ 5 mL	<b>Shelf Life:</b>	7 days
<b>Route:</b>	Oral	<b>Storage:</b>	Refrigerate
<b>Volume:</b>	125 mL	<b>Auxiliary Labeling:</b>	Shake Well

Ingredients	QS	Quantity	Units
Primaquine 26.3 mg (15 mg base) tablets		10	tablets
Carboxymethylcellulose 1.5%		10	mL
Simple syrup, NF	X	125	mL

## Directions:

1. Crush tablets in a mortar and grind into a fine powder.
2. Wet the powder with the small amounts of carboxymethylcellulose forming a smooth uniform paste.
3. Add half of the simple syrup mixing well.
4. Transfer to a graduate and QS to a final volume of 125 mLs .
