

Michigan Collaborative Standardization of Compounded Oral Liquids

Drug name:	SulfaDIAzine	Dosage Form:	Suspension
Concentration:	100 mg/mL	Shelf Life:	60 days
Route:	Oral	Storage:	Refrigeration (preferred) or Room Temp
Volume:	100 mL	Auxiliary Labeling:	Shake well; Refrigerate

Ingredients	QS	Quantity	Units
SulfaDIAzine 500 mg		20	tablets
Ora-Plus		50	mL
Ora-Sweet	Y	50	mL

Directions:

1. Crush sulfaDIAzine tablets in a mortar and pestle and triturate to fine powder
2. Wet powder with small amount of Ora-Plus, levigate into smooth paste
3. Add small amounts of Ora-Plus via geometric dilution to volume, mixing thoroughly after each addition
4. Transfer to graduated cylinder
5. Rinse mortar and pestle with Ora-Sweet and transfer to graduated cylinder
6. QS to 100 mL with Ora-Sweet
7. Mix well

Notes:

- May use sulfaDIAzine powder instead of tablets
