Directions:

- 1. Crush thiamine tablets in a mortar and pestle to a fine powder
- 2. Add a small amount of Ora-Plus and levigate to form a smooth paste
- 3. Add Ora-Plus via geometric dilution to volume, mixing thoroughly after each addition
- 4. Transfer to a graduated cylinder
- 5. Rinse the mortar and pestle with strawberry syrup and transfer to graduated cylinder
- 6. QS to 100 mL using Ora-Sweet
- 7. Transfer to glass amber bottle
- 8. Shake well

Notes:

May substitute thiamine hydrochloride powder instead of thiamine tablets
